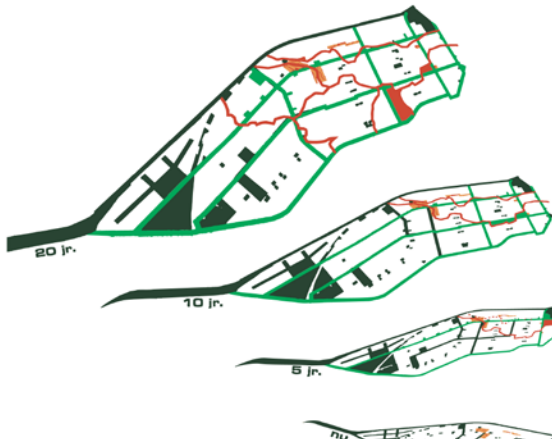


# SWIFTERBANT

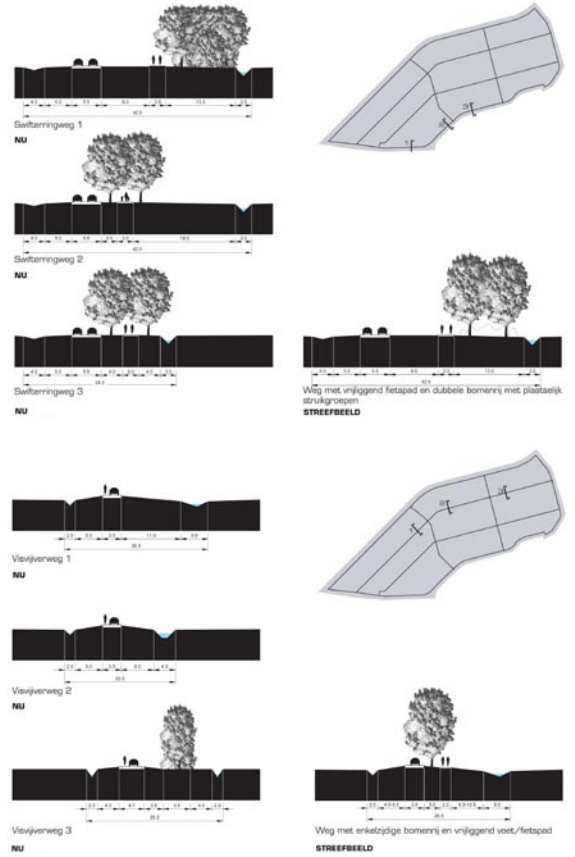
