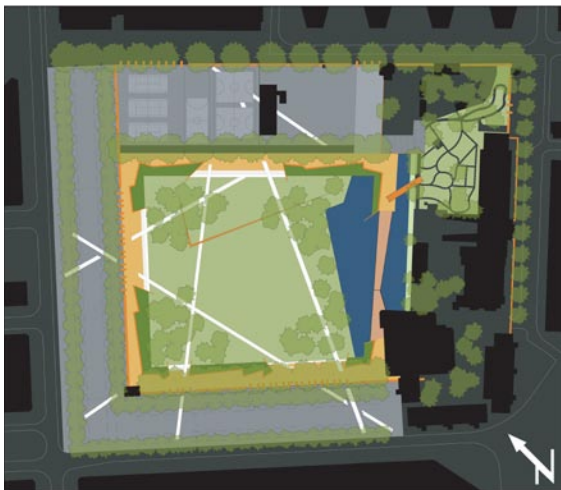

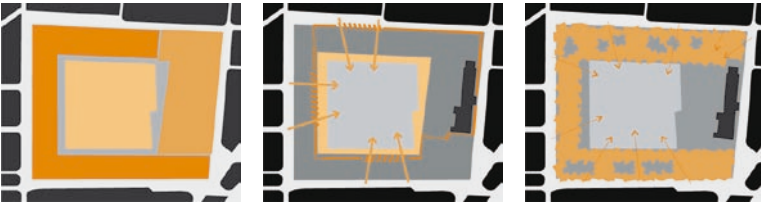
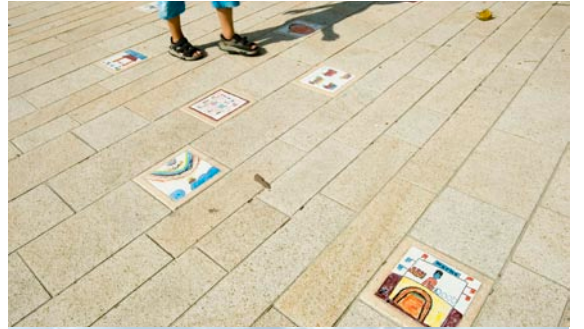

SITUATION BEFORE





Master plan concept:

1. free use centre and fixed use around (busy left, quiet right)
2. all vulnerable functions together within one fence, wide pivot gates guarantee a fluent connection with the surrounding streets
3. frame of large trees and focus on the monumental building
