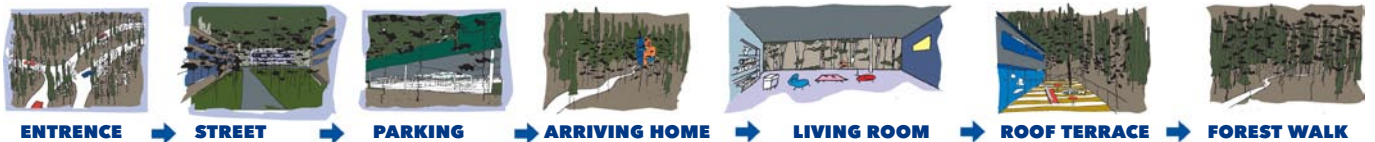


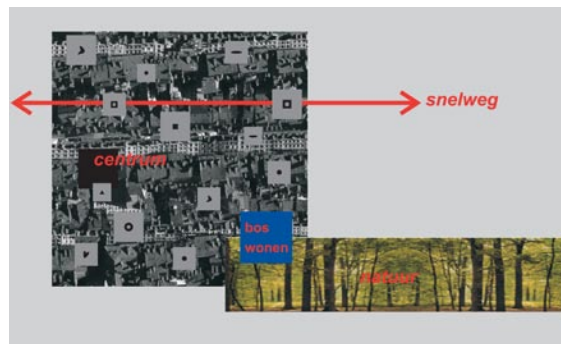

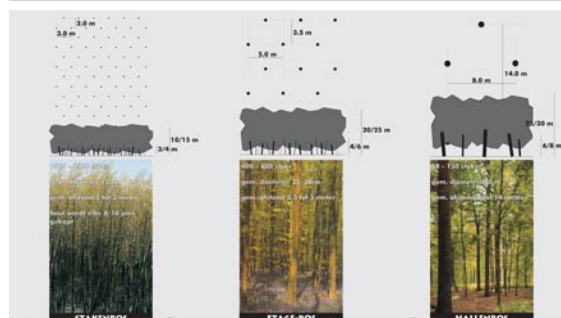

New urban concept for high density housing in forests, developed for the National government. Application and differentiation of the forest living concept on an existing forest in connection to a new residential district.



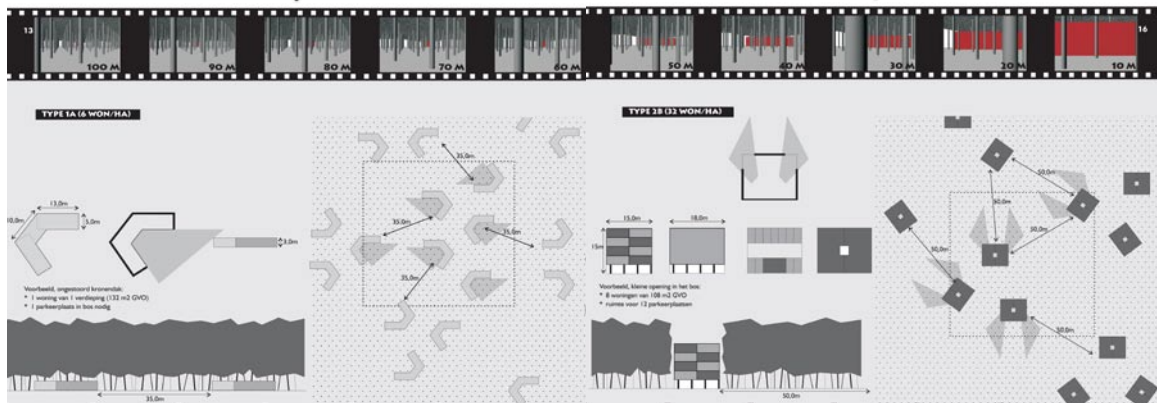
Best location for forest living: link between city and nature



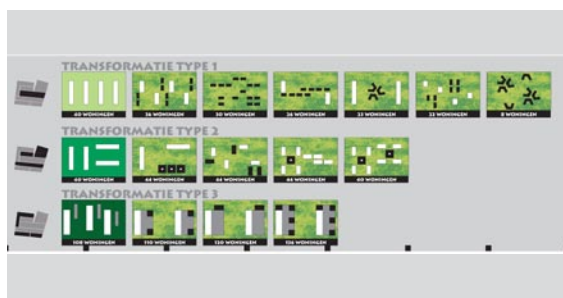
Different types of forest give different opportunities for urban use.
